The Consulate General of Malta in Victoria celebrated Malta's National Day on Wednesday 26th September 2012 by organising a reception for the Maltese community in Victoria. This was held at the Sir Redmond Barry Room, Investment Centre Victoria.

Attending were the Hon Nickolas Kotsiras, State Minister for Multicultural Affairs and Citizenship and the Hon Wade Noonan, representing the Leader of the Opposition of the Victorian Parliament. Also present were the Hon Bruce Atkinson, President of the Legisltive Council; representatives of the Victorian Department of Foreign affairs and Trade, members of the Victorian Parliament, members of the Victoiran Multicultural Commission and about 130 Maltese Australians representing the various associations in Victoria.


Salvina and Paul Vella were in attendance, representing the Reskeon Seniors Group and Radio 3ZZZ respectively.

10th Anniversary of the Bali Bombing

This year we're remembering the 10th Anniversary of the Bali Bombing by terrorists which killed 202 persons at the Sari Club. Out of these, 88 of them were Australians, one of whom was Maltese, Anthony Frances Cachia, 32, son of our members Carmen and Charles Cachia, of Reservoir.

During an interview with me for my program on Community Radio 3ZZZ, Carmen and Charles recollected the events of the night of that tragedy. They told me that they had dinner with their son, Anthony, daughter, Angela, her husband and two sons. After dinner, Charles asked his son to go to the hotel to watch car racing, a sport he loved so much, but Anthony told him that he had to meet some friends at the Sari Club.

When they were at the hotel asleep, around 11 pm, Charles and Carmen said they heard a loud explosion but didn't know what happened until Charlie's sister from Box Hill rang them to tell them they heard there was a bombing at Bali. It took six weeks for the authorities to find the body which was returned to Melbourne. A Mass was held at St Joseph the Worker. A few weeks ago, Carmen and Charlie travelled to Bali once again for the special ceremonies in remembrance of the innocent victims.
