### **Super Easy Pizza Dough**

(From Olga Ellul)

### **Ingredients:**

2 cups plain flour, 1 x 8g sachet of dry yeast,, 1 teaspoon castor sugar, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 2 tablespoons olive oil, 3/4 cup warm water.

### Method:

- 1. Combine dry ingredients in a large mixing bowl, add oil and water.
- 2. Mix to a soft dough.
- 3. Knead on a floured surface until soft and pliable.
- 4. Return to the mixing bowl an cover with cling wrap and leave in a warm spot for 30 minutes. The dough should double in size.
- 5. When it has risen, 'punch' the dough once to remove air bubbles.
- 6. Remove from bowl and knead gently for one minute.
- 7. Roll the dough out to desired size and add your favourite toppings.

Note: Roll the pastry thin as it rises in the oven
